Highlights

- We will visit America's greatest History Attraction - Henry Ford Museum, Greenfield Village, and the Ford Rouge Factory Tour.
- Discover the Bavarian Village of Frankenmuth, known as "Little Bavaria" and Bronner's the world's largest Christmas Shop. Check into the Bavarian Inn Lodge and listen to the Glockenspeil chimes before having the Ultimate Bavarian Combination Family Style Dinner at the Bavarian Inn Restaurant.
- Soo Locks Boat Cruise - referred to as one of the great wonders of the world and it is still the largest waterway traffic system on earth. Your tour boat will ride the water as it is raised twenty-one feet, straight up, to the level of Lake Superior. You will then cruise under the International Bridge before crossing into the Canadian waters. Your boat will let you experience all the sights and sounds of Michigan's oldest city, Sault Ste. Marie. No passport is required as you will not actually enter Canada.
- Ferry over to Mackinac Island where the charm of a bygone era is still preserved and motor vehicles are banned. Only form of transportation is by carriage and walking. You will check into the Lilac Tree Suites and Spa for two nights.
