My Dear Parishioners,

Today we hear St. Luke telling about something that happened at the very beginning of Jesus' ministry. It involved a small crowd in a little town and a very short sermon. But its implications were to reach the ends of the earth. Jesus stood up in his home town of Nazareth during his weekly observance of the Sabbath and quoted the words of the prophet Isaiah. Then his sermon: "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing."

What a claim to make in that setting! We might do well to listen once again to the words of the prophet that Jesus claims to fulfill: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord."

We believe that those words came true. They were proved in the person of Jesus Christ. Jesus is the long-awaited Messiah who came to proclaim liberty and justice and to reach out to the oppressed. We know that as a fact. We read about it in the New Testament. We are committed to that fact. But the question we need to ask today is do we REALLY believe it? Do we believe that those words of the prophet Isaiah have come true in the person of Jesus Christ? Are we committed to making them come true through the lives that we ourselves lead?

Jesus' life and mission proclaims to us that our God is a powerful God who cares for us and loves us. He is a God of hope, a God of justice and a God of freedom. We know this, because God demonstrated it. He showed it to us in the life of his only Son, Jesus Christ. It is our task to live this faith as a reality in our lives. Jesus truly is the Messiah of God – the anointed one who fulfilled the prophecies of old. But we also are a part of his ministry. Today we pray that we may join him in bringing the good news to all who are in need!
