Mary Scavenger Hunt Teaching Page

Here is what each item symbolizes to teach about God & Mary.

White: Shows something with no other marks or colors on it. It shows purity, being pure and being so so clean. When God made or created Mary, it was with no original sin. We call this the **Immaculate Conception**.

Book: We use books to learn about other things, places, or people. Mary learned about and loved God very much. She listened to and prayed to God. She listened to stories about God.

Yellow: Yellow reminds us of the sun, the warmth and light that comes from it. God sent the angel Gabriel to appear to Mary at the **Annunciation**.

Helping Item: Mary showed love by helping her cousin, St. Elizabeth. This is called the **Visitation**. Can you think of a time when you needed help, whether it was finding something or cleaning something? Think of how we feel happy when someone helps us.

Blanket: Blankets are so snugly and soft, something that can bring us calm and peace. The blanket reminds us of the story of Christmas, the **Nativity**, where Mary and Joseph wrapped Jesus in a blanket.

Car/Keys: Cars remind us of traveling. Mary and Joseph traveled to the Temple in Jerusalem to present Jesus to God, this is called the **Presentation**.

Glasses/Window: Mary and Joseph took Jesus to the Temple when he was young. They left the Temple and thought he was with the group of people they were traveling with, but he was still at the Temple. This is called the **Finding of Jesus at the Temple**.

Jumping Jacks: Jumping jacks remind us of the **Assumption** of Mary. As Catholics, we believe at the end of Mary's life on earth, she was assumed or brought up into heaven.

Stuffed Animal: When we hug a stuffed animal, we feel happiness and joy and peace. The stuffed animal reminds us of our hope to be with God in heaven, like Mary and the other saints are in heaven with God.

Blue: Blue reminds us of the sky or water, the great height or depth of God's love for everyone. Blue symbolizes heavenly grace and our hope to one day be in heaven.
