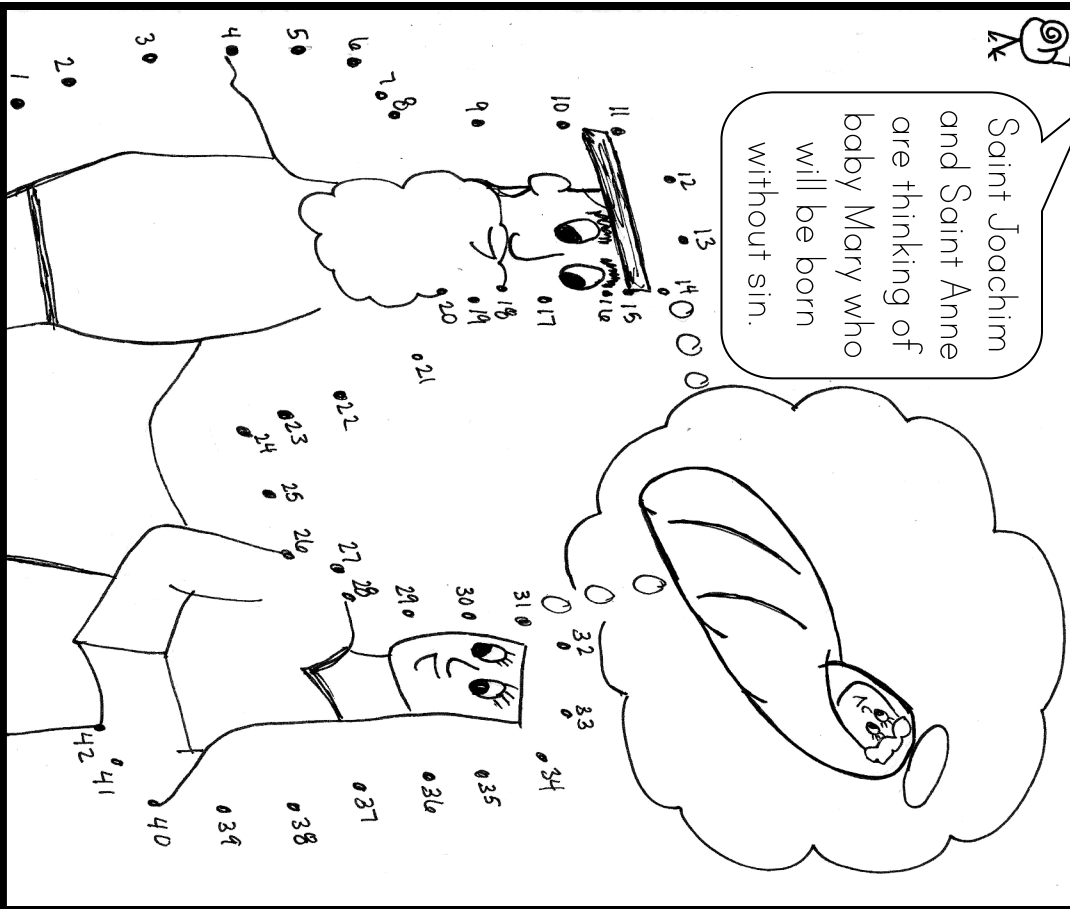



Immaculate Conception

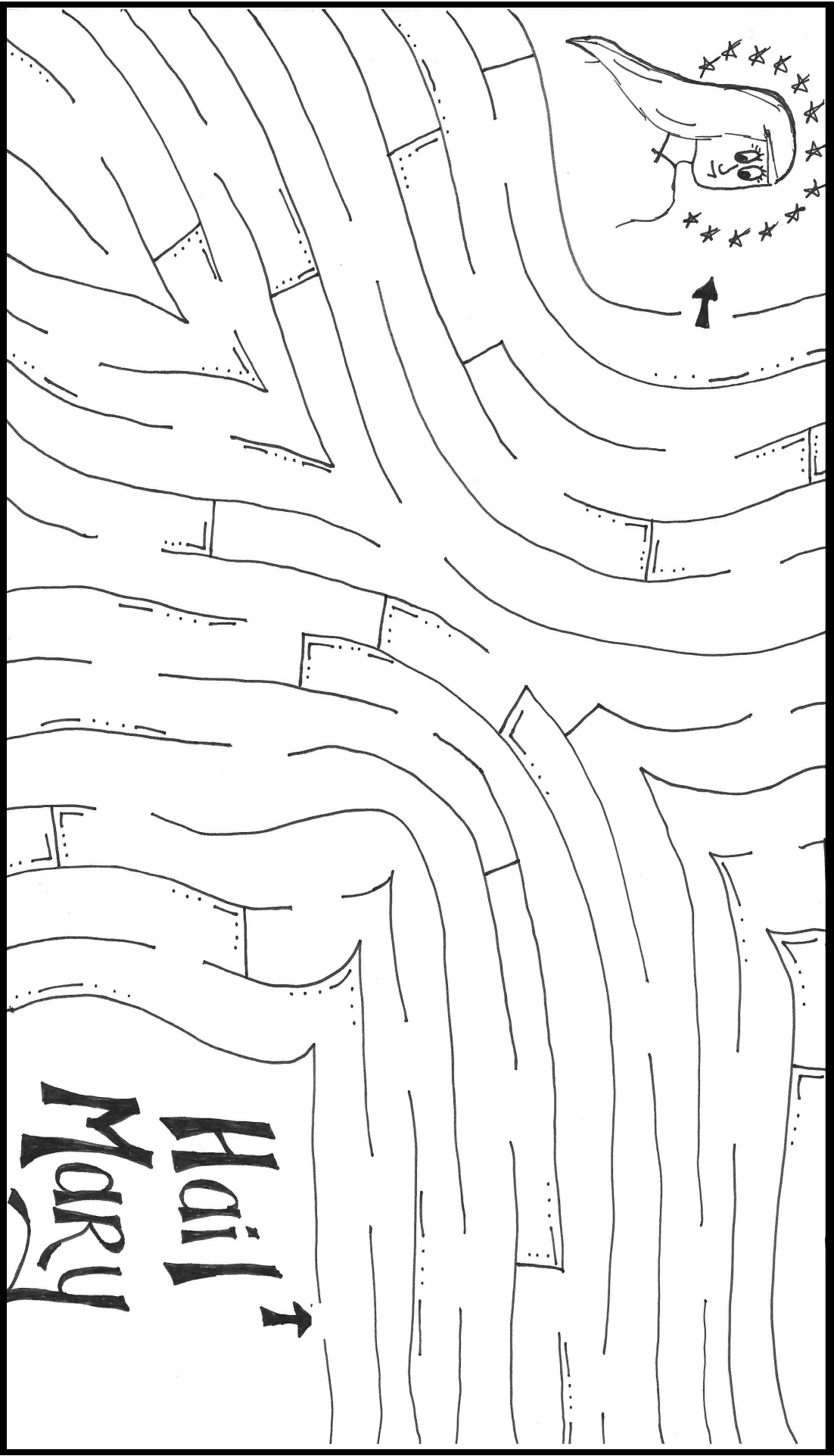
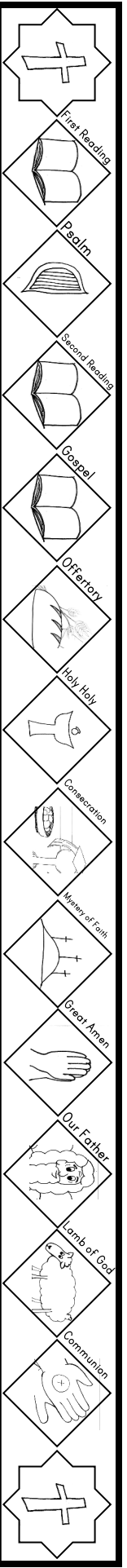

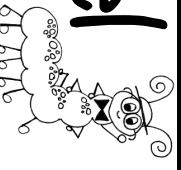
