Second Sunday in Ordinary Time January 14, 2024



My Dear Parishioners,

Who among us is content being considered simply "ordinary?" We would like to stand out from the crowd, to be recognized as "somebody." Yet most of us are really ordinary people living quite ordinary lives. Notwithstanding, there really need be nothing ordinary about being ordinary.

In this Sunday we return to "ordinary time." It is actually the interlude between two important seasons. We are leaving behind the excitement and warmth of the Christmas season, but have not yet entered the sober experience of Lent followed by the glory of the Pascal mystery. Ordinary time is a period in which we reflect on the very ordinary ways that God enters our lives. But in fact His entry into our lives makes our lives truly extraordinary.

Our readings this weekend tell the story: The young boy Samuel was entrusted to the old man Eli. This was a common situation, yet something extraordinary happened.

Jesus' appearance was so unremarkable that the Baptist had to point Him out, and then something extraordinary happened.

Perhaps what Paul describes is the most startling. Ordinary human beings are members of Christ; their bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit.

In these three incidents, the extraordinary was not apparent. At first, both Samuel and Eli misunderstood the voice; Paul rebuked Christians who had lost sight of their dignity; initially the disciples of John saw nothing unusual in Jesus. These people were only aware of what was obvious.

We are not unlike these biblical people. We do not always look beneath the surface. So we often miss the extraordinary in what is ordinary. We do not hear the voice of God in the voices of others calling us to great things, to sacrifice ourselves for our children or give of ourselves to aging parents. We do not recognize Christ in the thoughtful people with whom we work, the honest people with whom we do business, the understanding people who help us in simple ways: the ordinary people with whom we live.

Today as we come together in church, let us remind ourselves of the importance of opening our eyes to see with the eyes of faith. Seen with the eyes of faith, we can recognize the extraordinary in the seemingly ordinary. We can begin to contemplate the mystery of God's presence in even the apparently most ordinary things and people in this world. And we can recognize that even in living the most ordinary of lives, that God is present to us — and that with Him everything assumes a most extraordinary aspect!

How to Prepare for a Doctor's Appointment

We've all been there. Your doctor asks "How are you?" and you reply "fine". We are reluctant to talk about what really bothers us or symptoms we are having. We may struggle with trying to describe what has been happening accurately not wanting to either underreport a problem or to exaggerate. Here's a suggestion. Try quantifying. There is a big difference in these answers. Well, I'm not sleeping very well. And this description. In the last two weeks, 10 of those nights it took me more than an hour to fall asleep. With the second answer, the health care provider has a more accurate understanding of just how prevalent the sleep disturbances occur. With the more accurate description, the provider has an opportunity to provide an intervention targeted to you. So, the next time you want to describe a symptom, try quantifying.

A few more suggestions that might be helpful as you prepare for your next medical appointment:

- Make a list of questions and prioritize your concerns.
- Remember to bring your health insurance cards.
- Take information with you to the doctor, including any appropriate medical records if you have them.
- Bring a list of all of medications including vitamins and nutritional supplements. Also any allergies to medications food, and seasonal allergies should be recorded and discussed with your health care provider since they may influence which medications you can or cannot take
- Consider bringing a family member or friend to the doctor's visit.
- Know your family health history as it may have a significant impact on your current health and wellbeing.
- Be sure you can see and hear as well as possible.
- Take notes and jot down important information that come up during your appointment.
- Don't leave until all of your questions have been answered and you understand what to do next. Take note paper to jot down important information that comes up during your appointment.
