Ms. Johnstone's third-grade students at St. Jane School experience tremendous growth both spiritually and academically. It has been a year of growth in faith as the students study the Apostles' Creed, our foundation and identity as Catholics. Children experience opportunities to live out their faith by attending weekly and prayer services, receiving the sacraments, and helping others through works of service.

Academically, our third-grade curriculum here at St. Jane School upholds the tradition of excellence. Much of our math instruction is spent understanding the meaning of multiplication and division concepts. Building models, creating arrays, and skip counting are some of the strategies the students have learned to help them master these basic facts. The students love playing games like Zoom, Splat, and Around the World with their classmates. Logging on to Math 24, and Happy Numbers online math programs, are another fun way for the students to reinforce and enrich math concepts.

In reading children focus on comprehension, strategies, and vocabulary skills such as author's point of view, main idea, cause and effect, visualizing, re-reading, and, synonyms, antonyms, prefixes, suffixes, and idioms to increase their understanding of reading a text. We work on our fluency, rate, expression, and tone as readers. We explore many different genres and discuss the differences.

At St. Jane School the third graders are currently learning about the United States' government and how it works. They are learning about the different branches of government and the functions of those branches. We spent time discussing and making hands-on flip books to show the duties of local, state, and federal governments and how these all work.

In science, we have spent time investigating and learning about the scientific method. Through teacher demonstrations, cooperative learning activities, and hands-on tasks the students examine the world around them. The children had a great time participating in a hands-on science workshop during Catholic Schools Week from Mad Science called "Up, Up and Away" where they were introduced to the principles of air and pressure.

As you can see, our third graders have a lot of fun as they grow in their faith and learn so many new things!

Quick Tips for Healthy Eating with Diabetes

Good nutrition is a basic and important diabetes care tool. Eating healthy can help control blood sugar. And good control protects your long-term health and reduce the risk of diabetes complications.

Diets for people living with diabetes are often based on eating healthy meals at regular times. The practice of eating meals at regular times helps one's body to better use the insulin that it makes and/or gets through medicine.

Suggestions to consider include:

- Eat three meals a day and an evening snack. Do not skip meals, especially if on insulin or taking pills for diabetes.

- Control your portions and reduce temptations for seconds by keeping the serving bowls out of reach.

- Include fresh fruit, vegetables, low fat dairy products, lean meats, fish, poultry, tofu, and whole grains.

- Choose chicken without the skin, lean cuts of meats, or fish. Trim fats that you can see.

- Limit desserts/sweets and sugars. Avoid syrup, candy, jellies, cookies, and honey, or try the sugar free or diet types of these foods.

- Consider using sugar substitutes as a sweetener. Drink water rather than regular soda.

- Select canned fruits that are packed in its own juice and without sugar. Try unsweetened frozen fruit.

- Watch your weight. If you need to lose weight, do it slowly, usually 1-2 lbs. per week and inform your health care provider. If you lose weight without trying, talk with your doctor.

- Include exercise as part of your daily activity.

- Walking is a great way to exercise.

- Include high fiber foods in your diet. Fiber will help control your blood sugars. Fiber is found in many fresh fruits, vegetables, and whole grain breads and cereals.

Consult with registered dietitian and/or your health care provider to help you put together a diet based on your health goals, food preferences, and lifestyle.

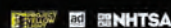
